Car & Driver Registration:

All Hornet cars are invited to join this event (see specific rules below).

Maximum of 25 spots open for registration.

Early Bird Registration	\$100 *includes Pit Pass for car & one (1) driver
Valid until March 15, 2025	Must be registered <u>and</u> paid by March 15, 2025 , to receive early bird pricing.
Regular Registration	\$125 *includes Pit Pass for one (1) driver
valid after March 16, 2025	
Pit Pass	\$25 per person (crew and additional drivers)
	*payable at pit gate on race day

Main Event Format:



10 minute break between Stage 1 & 2

Starting Lineup:

The starting lineup will be determined by pill draw on the day of the event.

Hornet Enduro Specific Rules:

- Home track rules on Agassiz tires.
- Minimum treadwear of 400 or greater. No racing tires.
- Supply a copy of your home track rules (upload link with registration).
- Switching drivers is allowed (no minimum of drivers per car).
- Driver skill level: Any driver can drive (must be 14+ years of age).
- Personal safety equipment is mandatory including: driver's suit, helmet, and gloves.
- All cars must be checked in at the pit gate by 12:00 PM to allow time for safety inspections.

General Rules:

- If your car number is in use by an Agassiz member, you will be asked to put a letter after your number on the car (i.e.: 01X) or you use the initial of your last name.
- No parking or working on cars on the pit asphalt.
- No floor jacks or jack stands allowed on asphalt. If floor jacks or jack stands are required,
 please use them on the gravel or in a concrete pit stall. Violation of this rule may result in a fine.
- Leaking fluid: Drive on the grass or go straight to your pit stall.
- Please drive slowly through the pits, speeding in the pits may result in a fine or your car being parked.
- Each car/driver must have a **broom and working fire extinguisher** in their pit area.
- Tow vehicles, trailers, or personal vehicles must part in designated areas outside of the Pit Area.
- Use or consumption of alcohol or drugs are not permitted during the event (until the final checked flag for all race events).
- Vehicles going in or out of the track area must have a walker on the right side of the trailer and/or car. Vehicles without a walker may be issued a fine at the discretion of the Pit Boss and/or Executive.
- Pit Gate Entry:
 - Closes at the start of the event and will remain closed until 20 minutes following the trophy presentation.
 - If entry is required after the gate is closed, arrangements must be made with the Pit Boss and/or a Track Official.
- During the event, do not enter the track surface. If entry is required, permission must be obtained from the Pit Boss or a Track Official.

Electronic Waivers:

Electronic waivers can be found here: https://agassizspeedway.speedwaiver.com/kebji

- Waivers must be completed for each person entering the pits.
- **Minimum age of entry to the pits is 14.** All minors are required to have a waiver completed by their parent or guardian and the individual waiver completed by the minor. Link above.

Racecievers:

Must be used by all drivers. Ensure batteries and ear buds are working. Raceciever checks will be completed in the staging area.

Transponders:

TR2 or TransX (red version) transponders are compatible with our system. Transponders **must** be used during hot laps, qualifying, and racing events. Rental transponders are available at the pit gate for \$20.

Track Address:

5045 Cemetery Rd., Agassiz, BC V0M 1A1

Track Info:

Track size is ¼ mile, medium-low banking.

Camping:

Dry camping is available in designated areas of the spectator parking lot or in Alm Park, (located on the road just past the pit gate). *Note: There is no power (or hook ups), and anything brought in must be taken out.*

Hotels:

There are hotel/motel options available close by in Harrison Hot Springs, approximately a 20-minute drive from the track. Visit www.tourismharrison.com/hotels-and-resorts for accommodation info.
