

Agassiz Speedway Hornet Enduro Rules



Car & Driver Registration:

We're gearing up for an exciting Hornet Enduro at Agassiz Speedway, featuring our unique ROVAL format, which combines the oval track with a road course through the paved infield and pit area.

All Hornet cars are invited to join this event (*see specific rules below*).

- **Early Bird Registration:** \$100 (*must be registered and must be paid by October 25, 2024*)
**includes Pit Pass for one (1) driver.*
- **Regular Registration:** \$150 (*October 26 or later*) **includes Pit Pass for one (1) driver.*
- **Pit Pass:** \$25 per person (*crew and additional drivers*)

Starting Lineup:

The starting lineup will be determined by date/time of registration—payment must be received for registration to be complete.

Minimum Car Count Requirement:

To proceed with this event, we need 25 paid registrations by October 25, 2024, to cover the costs of the event. If the minimum car count is not met, the event will be canceled. In the event of cancellation, refunds will be provided to the original payment method (*eTransfer/credit card, etc.*).

Race Information:

Hornet Enduro Specific Rules:

- Home track rules on Agassiz tires.
- Minimum treadwear of 400 or greater. **No racing tires.**
- Bring copy of your home track rules (*paper copy or link to electronic copy*).
- Switching Drivers is allowed (no minimum of drivers per car).
- Driver skill level: Any driver can drive (**must be 14+ years of age**).
- Personal safety equipment is mandatory, driver's suit, helmet, gloves.
- All cars must be checked in at the pit gate by 12:00 PM to allow time for safety inspections.

General Rules:

- If your car number is in use by an Agassiz member, you will be asked to put a letter after your number on the car i.e.: 01X or you may use the initial of your last name.
- We will try to provide you with a paved pit spot; however, you may park on the grass or gravel.
- **No parking or working on cars on the pit asphalt.**
- Use of floor jacks or jack stands is **not allowed** on asphalt. If floor jacks or jack stands are required, please use them on the gravel or in a concrete pit stall. Violation of this rule may result in a fine.
- If your car is leaking fluid, please drive on the grass or go straight to your pit stall.
- Please drive slowly through the pits, speeding in the pits may result in a fine or your car being parked.
- All drivers are required to have a **broom and fire extinguisher** in the pits with them.
- **No parking of tow vehicles, trailers, or personal vehicles in the Pit Area**, all vehicles must be parked outside in designated areas.
- **No drinking or drugs allowed** to be consumed in the pits until the final checkered flag is flown for all races.
- Any vehicle going in or out of the track requires a walker on the right side of the trailer and/or car. If there is no trailer walker present, the driver may receive a fine at the discretion of the Pit Boss and/or Executive.
- Once the Pit Gate is closed there will be no leaving or entering, unless arrangements have been made with the Pit Boss and/or Track Official. The Back Gate will remain closed until 20 minutes after the end of the final Trophy Presentation.
- Once racing has started, no matter the situation, no one is to step out onto the track without permission from the Pit Boss and/or Track Official.

Electronic Waivers:

- Waivers must be completed for each person entering the pits.
- **Minimum age of entry to the pits is 14.** All minors are required to have a waiver completed by their parent or guardian and the individual waiver completed by the minor. Link above.

Raceciewers:

Must be used by all drivers. Ensure batteries are working. Checks will be made in the staging area.

Transponders:

TR2, X2, or TransX (red version) transponders are compatible with our system. Transponders must be used during hot laps, qualifying, and racing events. If you don't have your own, rental transponders are available at the pit gate for \$20.

Track Address:

Track Info:

Track size is ¼ mile, medium – low banking.

Camping:

Dry camping is available in designated areas of the spectator parking lot or in Alm Park, (located on the road just past the pit gate). **Note: There is no power (or hook ups), and anything brought in must be taken out.**

Hotels:

There are lots of hotel/motel options available in Harrison Hot Springs, approximately a 20-minute drive from the track. Visit www.tourismharrison.com/hotels-and-resorts for accommodation info.
